*Definition Of Spouse As Defined By The British Columbia Pension Legislation - Pension Benefits Standards Act

Relevant time means the date of the member's retirement or the day of the member's death, if earlier.

If a Plan Member or Former Plan Member was last employed in British Columbia, "Spouse" shall mean the person who:

- is married to the Plan Member or Former Plan Member and who, if living separate and apart from the Plan Member or Former Plan Member, did not live separate and apart from him or her for longer than the 2-year period immediately preceding the relevant time,or
if there is no person to whom paragraph (a) applies, a person who was living and cohabiting with the Plan Member or Former Plan Member in a marriage-like relationship, including a marriage-like relationship between persons of the same gender, and who had been living and cohabiting in that relationship for a period of at least 2 years immediately preceding the relevant time.
